Paso Robles has an exceptionally wide range of environmental conditions throughout the appellation: soils, climate, topography, you name it. This is why there has been so much talk of splitting it up into a dozen sub-appellations. Cab is grown in all of them. Hence the myriad styles coming out of here. In our little section of Paso, our estate vineyard creates a wine that seems to have more in common with the Barosa cabs than with our neighbors with its dense, velvety tannins and red fruits. That's fine with me. --Adam LaZarre

Classical flavors of black cherry, plum, and bittersweet chocolate are braced by lush, melting tannins. 16 months of aging in a blend of new and neutral French Oak barrels lends alluring cedar and spice notes to the melange."
