2009 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Paso Robles has an exceptionally wide range of environmental conditions throughout the appellation: soils, climate, topography, you name it. This is why there has been so much talk of splitting it up into a dozen sub-appellations. Cab is grown in all of them. Hence the myriad styles coming out of here. In our little section of Paso, our estate vineyard creates a wine that seems to have more in common with the Barossa Cabs than with our neighbors with its dense, velvety tannins and red fruits. That's fine with me.

The 2009 Villa San-Juliette Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a dizzying array of aromas and flavors thanks in part to the variety of oak barrels and blenders I used to finish up the wine. Mocha, cigar tobacco, and chocolate nuances over the top of ripe blackberry, currant, and plum flavors. Lush, resolved tannins with a nice grainy texture are supported with a fairly persistent acidity. The mouthfeel is really quite nice.
